



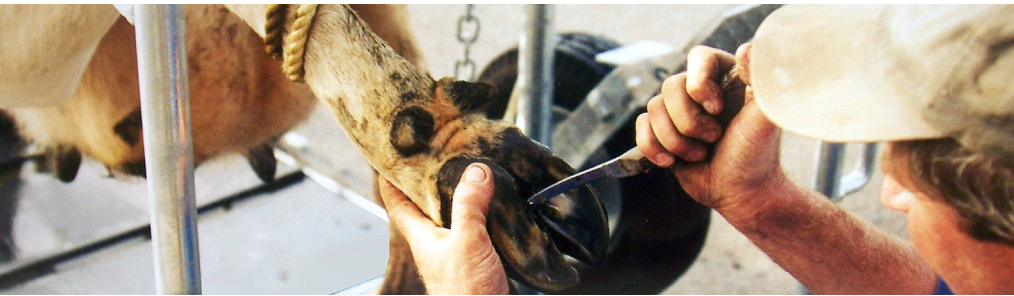

Arriving on farm with a Pro Wrangler, you will be set to treat cows in complete safety and hassle free ease. The Pro Wrangler has all the bells and whistles for vets, hoof care professionals, or serious farmers to tackle any treatment. Fully kitted out with equipment, the Pro also has duratorque suspension and 12" rims, registration and light bar for smooth towing anywhere. Simply drop the wheels, remove the tow bar and lights and you are ready for action.



Pro Wrangler

- Two Wooden Front Foot Attachments with winches, removable handles, kwila blocks, straps, and braid.
- 4:1 Stainless Steel Braked Back Leg Winch, Rope, & Guide Bar with 3 height/length settings
- Rear closing adjustable Headbail Gate
- Quick Release Back chain
- Removable Sidebars on Left & Right Flank
- 25:1 Geared Belly Winch with two 150mm Underbelly Girths
- Rear Gudgeons and 2 lead-in gates
- Large drop down wheels with mudguards and duratorque suspension, Jockey Wheel
- Rubber Mat over solid floor
- Registration Bar with Lights.

How it works

The double belly straps hold the cow, immobilising and relaxing her, and preventing her from 'going down' and breaking a hip during treatment. The back hoof is then winched to a supporting bar leaving the operator with both hands free and out of the way of the knife. The front hoof is winched onto a wooden cradle and held securely with a second rope.

Operations can be performed by removing the right or left side bars, whilst using one or two of the belly straps to prevent the cow from falling. When finished, the Pro can be road ready again by attaching the towbar, lights, and raising the Wrangler onto its wheels.
